# The Challenge

For years, the school faced unreliable access to clean water.

Dormitories, classrooms, the kitchen, and the sick bay all struggled with shortages—impacting hygiene, health, and daily learning.



# A Campus- Wide Solution

OGS Foundation supported a comprehensive water restoration plan.

New water tanks, reinforced platforms, modern plumbing connections, and system repairs were installed across the campus to ensure long-term reliability.



# Girls' Dormitory

A dedicated water tank and reinforced platform now serve the girls' dormitory.

Students have reliable access to clean water for hygiene, sanitation, and daily living.



# Boys' Dormitory

High-capacity dual water tanks were installed to meet increased demand.

This upgrade significantly expanded storage capacity and improved water reliability.



# Kitchen & Nutrition

A dedicated water system now supports safe food preparation.

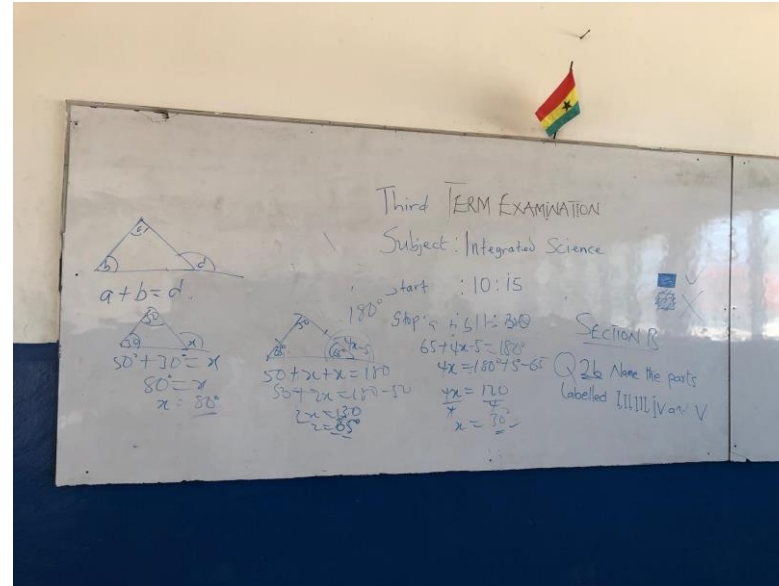
New plumbing, pumps, and reinforced platforms ensure consistent water access for daily meals.
